

*This page contains my idea for extending Total Commander's functionality which (I hope) will be implemented someday.*

First try to do something like this:

1. in usercmd.ini file define section similar to:  
[em\_test] Menu=test Cmd=D:picture.jpg button=
2. assign **em\_test** to **notepad** alias

Now, writing **notepad** in command line will give You picture preview. Before 2nd step: typing **notepad** was giving notepad application.

My proposal is that TC should check for existing Windows aliases and give a warning about overwriting it.

Or maybe give alternates:

1. warning dialog with assign / change alias / cancel buttons
2. assign alias to TC but give Information about possibility of executing system registry alias via Shift+Enter (this should be implemented)
